Today there was a social media post regarding a potential threat at CHS. As a result a lock in/ lock out was put in place at Central High school while the Bridgeport Police Department conducted a thorough search of the entire campus.

Upon further investigation it was determined that the threat referenced had been generated at Clovis High School in New Mexico [Clovis High School Threat](#) where authorities investigated and apprehended a suspect.

This afternoon Bassick High School received a bomb threat. Students were safely evacuated while Police conducted a thorough search of the entire campus. After the investigation by Bridgeport Police Department, all students were able to return to the school without incident.

A phone blast of both incidents was sent to parents of Central High School and Bassick High School students.

As a precautionary effort, all resource officers remained on the campuses until dismissal.
