The Bassick High School Chapter of the National Honor Society is a nationally affiliated prestigious organization that believes in the value and power of recognition. To be eligible for membership, candidates must:

- **Be a student in Bassick High School- grades 11& 12**
- **Maintain a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 and above**
- **Demonstrate kindness, compassion, and willingness to help others**
- **Exhibit an excellent record of behavior for the past two years**
- **Active participation in leadership roles both in school and the community**
- **Enthusiastic Bassick role models for the freshmen & sophomores**

Membership in NHS is based on the four pillars - **Scholarship, Character, Leadership, and Service**. Scholars get invited in their Junior and Senior year to NHS based on their GPA and excellent character traits. All invited scholars will have to complete an application for membership and a recommendation letter from one of your teachers. A faculty council composed of staff members and the NHS advisor will review the applications and determine the final selection of students. Attendance protocols and the election of office members (President, Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer) will be discussed in detail in our meetings this fall.

Upon selection, the National Honor Society members have the responsibility to continue demonstrating the qualities of Scholarship, Leadership, Service, and Character. By applying for NHS, scholars give their consent to follow the guidelines of the Bassick NHS Chapter. Meetings will be held once a week after school hours, and NHS members are required to attend them without fail. Absence in attending consecutive meetings without notice will hinder your membership status. NHS members are expected to participate in service projects in school and play an active role in fundraising efforts. There will be a zero-tolerance policy for violations of the BHS Code of Conduct.
