## NOTIFICATION TO PARENTS VIA EMAIL, PHONE BLAST, VOICEMAIL AND SMS TEXT MESSAGE

Dear Parents:

On August 26, 2019, the Board of Education voted to restore the transportation limits in the Transportation Policy, which are:

- For Elementary and Middle Schools: 1.0 mile
- For High Schools: 2.0 miles

If your child is eligible to receive bus transportation, please disregard all prior communications. You may obtain the **updated** bus route information [Bus Stop, Bus Stop Time and Bus Number] **starting Tuesday, August 27<sup>th</sup>**, as follows:

- View the route in the email from the central office, that you will receive if an email address is on file.
- Listen to the voicemail and/or view the text message delivered to the telephone number on file.
- At the district's website, enter the parent portal (<https://bridgeportedu.powerschool.com/public/home.html>).
- Contact the clerical at your child's school, who can view your child's route information in InfoFinder.
- Call the Transportation Command Center at 203-275-1020.
