District Student Device On-Loan Program Primer

Bridgeport Public Schools is now offering the ability for students to take their school assigned device home for children to use for the express purpose of their educational work while a student of the District. This program is now possible due to the CSDE/ Dalio Partnership which has provided devices to Districts that qualify for this need, of which Bridgeport is a recipient.

This program requires the Parent/Guardian to accept the full financial liability of taking the device home. While insurance is not required at this time, it is strongly recommended so as to alleviate any possibility to pay for a fully damaged, lost or stolen device.

Student Device Hand Out Priority

Devices are handed out to students in the following priority schedule and is subject to change based on the availability of equipment and conditions in relation to the COVID-19 Pandemic.

- All High School Students
- All Pre-Kindergarten to 8th Grade Distance Learners
- All In-Person Learners (At the discretion of their school, please see your school's local policy)

Student Device Equipment Details

- Equipment supply may vary due to the constantly changing enrollment and the demand at each individual school *may limit quantities and immediate availability*.
- The District and each school will make every effort to provide a decide in the following modality below, but no guarantee is made of such.
- High School student devices are new this year as delivered by the CSDE, while equipment stock lasts
- Elementary Equipment issued may either be **new or used**. The District will be receiving more equipment as it becomes available
