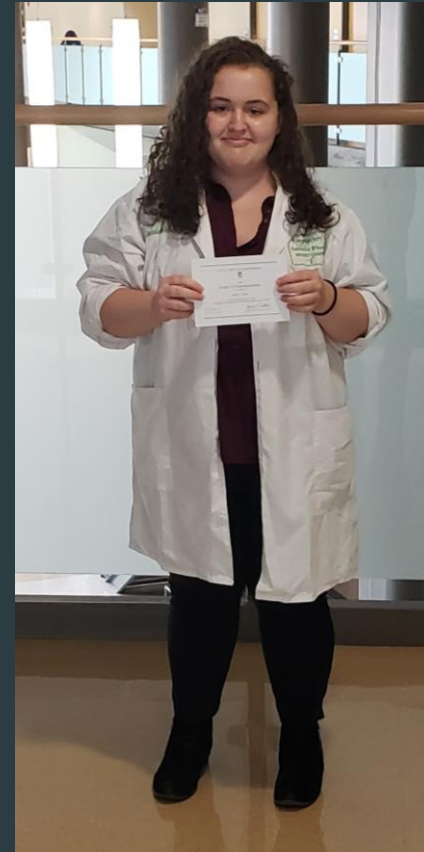


Commended Student in the 2021 National Merit® Scholarship Program

Mission

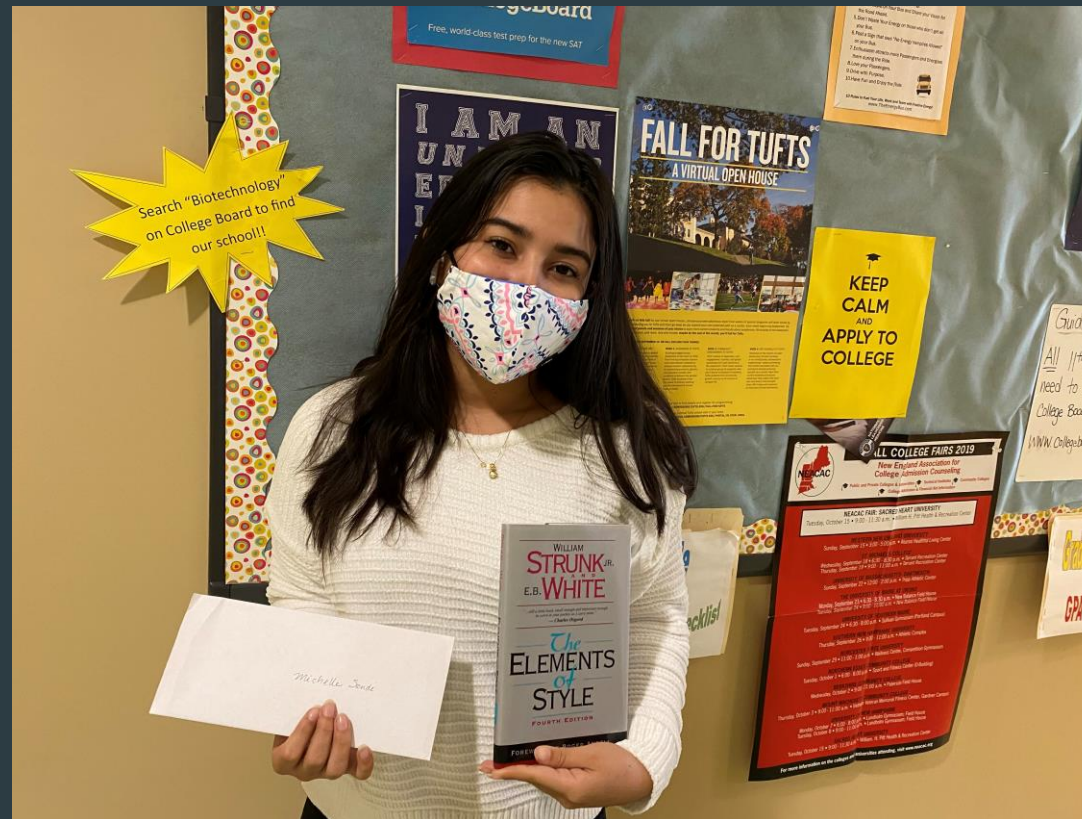

- We believe college and career readiness for every student and children will have experience in both.

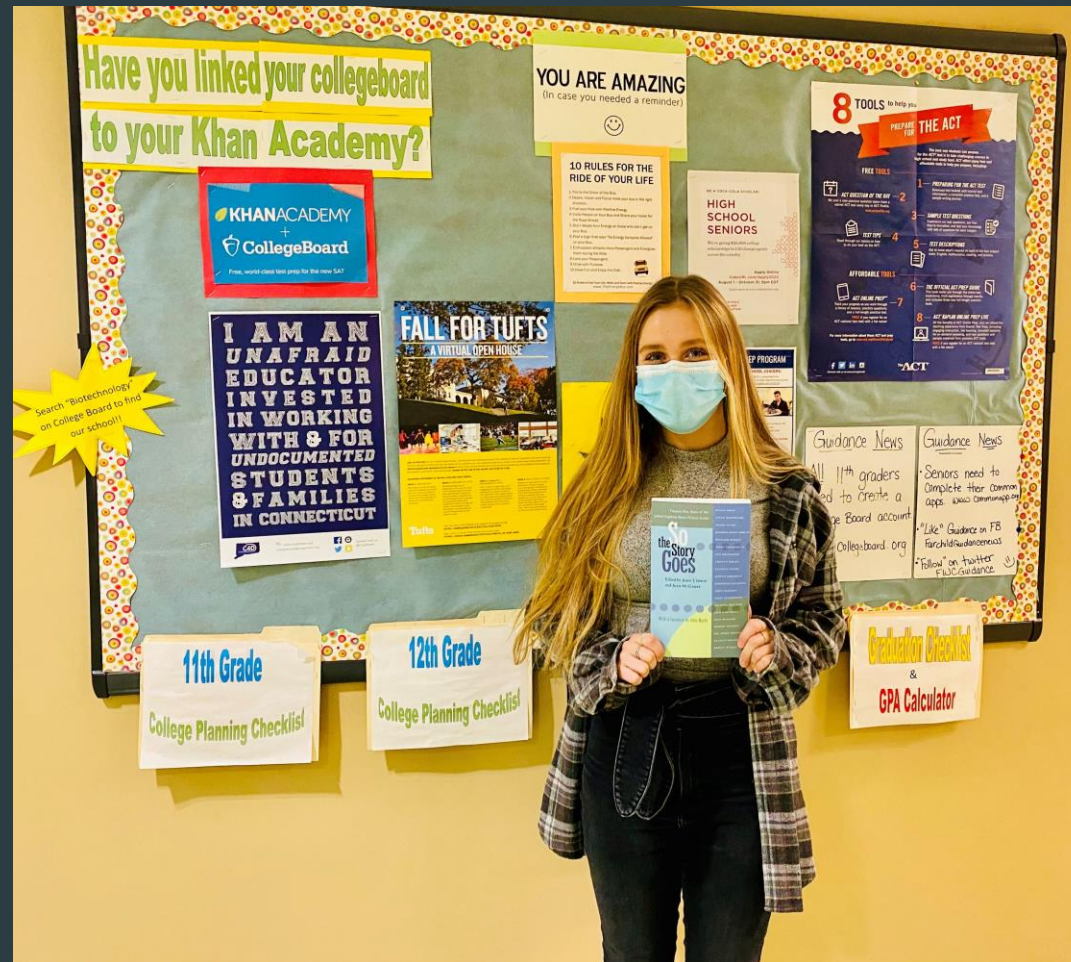
