

Student guide: getting started with Official SAT[®] Practice on Khan Academy

Welcome! Your district purchased Khan Academy Districts to help you practice and prepare for an upcoming PSAT, SAT, or NMSQT exam.

Did you know that spending just 6 hours of learning time on your personalized learning path along with taking at least **one full-length practice test** has led to an average SAT score increase of 39 points? Likewise, many students find that just 10 minutes of practice per day helped them score much higher on their SAT exams.

Getting Started:

To receive your personalized learning path, you need to create and link your Khan Academy account to your CollegeBoard account.

Create a College Board account:

- Go to: <https://www.collegeboard.org>
- Click **Create Account as a Student**.
- Complete the form to create your new CollegeBoard account using your **district email address**.

Link your CollegeBoard account to your Khan Academy account:

- Log in to your [Khan Academy](#) account with your district email address.
- Then, click your name in the upper right corner of the screen and select **Settings**.
- Go to the **Connect to CollegeBoard.org** section of your account settings. Click the blue **Connect to CollegeBoard.org** button.

Connecting your CollegeBoard.org account synchronizes your Khan Academy practice schedule to your registered test date and updates your practice recommendations with your latest official SAT, PSAT/NMSQT®, PSAT 10, or PSAT 8/9 results.

We share your Official SAT Practice activity with College Board only if your account is connected.

- Next, you will be taken to your CollegeBoard account. Enter your CollegeBoard account login credentials.
- You will be prompted to approve sharing your CollegeBoard data with Khan Academy. Click **Send**. Your accounts are now linked, and you are ready to begin!
