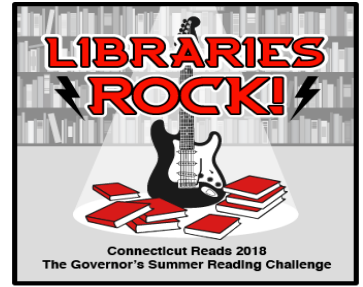


# Summer Reading 2018

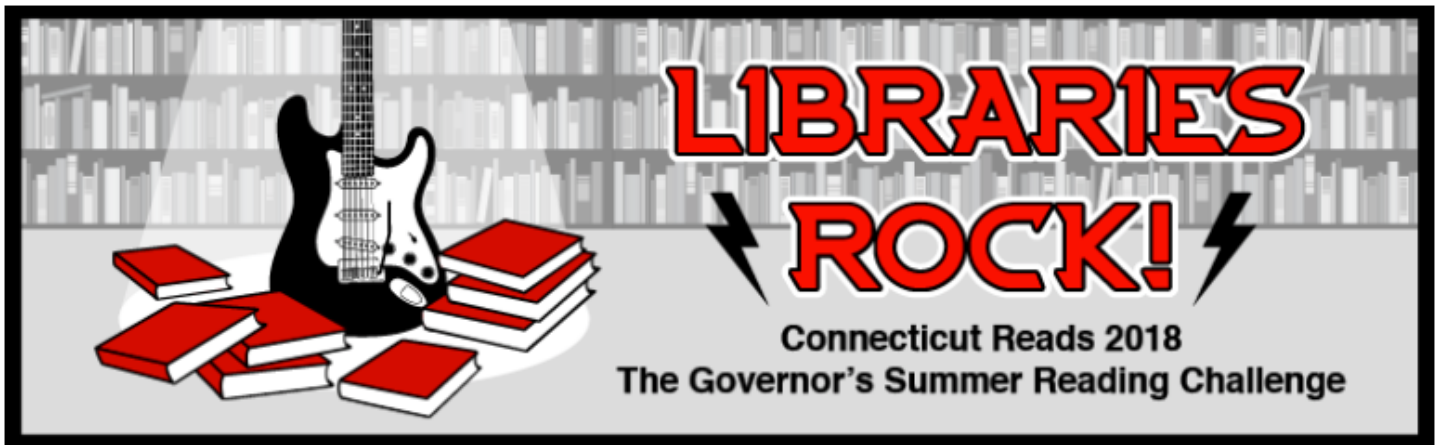
