

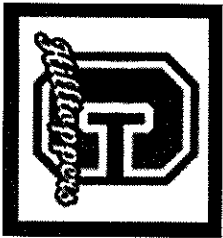

FACTS YOU NEED TO KNOW

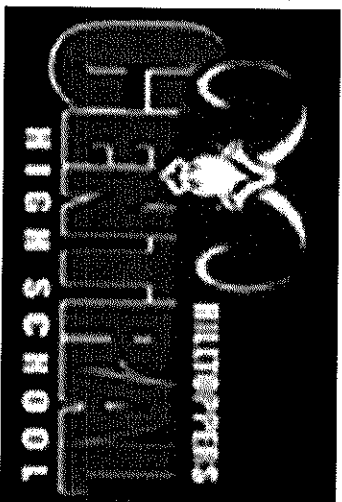
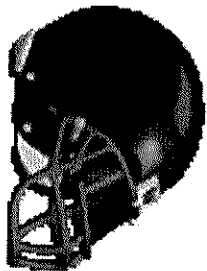
- HHMS 8th grade students are fed to Central Magnet as long as they meet the academic requirements (no Ds or Fs AT ALL in 7th or 8th grade!)
- All high schools requiring applications determine acceptance by 7th grade final grades, standardized test scores, attendance record, behavior reports, recommendations letters & 1st quarter 8th grade grades.
- **NOT ALL OF THE HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAMS ARE FULL DAY**
- **EVERY** application requires a parent signature & will **NOT** be accepted without it!!!
- Applications must be submitted by the deadline determined by the counselor, not what is on the application.
- **Applications must be 100% complete (except for counselor portion) when they are submitted.**
- Application fees should be submitted directly to the private high schools
- Applications cannot be submitted to surrounding public schools! Only the high schools with specialized programs have an admittance process. Exception: Open Choice
- Please call private high schools directly for financial aid/scholarship programs.

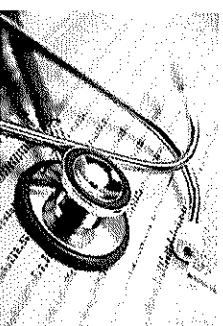
- **Must maintain a C+ or better average and have no Ds or Fs on 7th or 8th grade report card in order to secure a seat.**
- **Non-magnet students must complete a paper application by 11/2018 and then enter the lottery if chosen. Electronic application due by 2/2019 and lottery is run 3/2019.**
- **Open House October 11 (5-6:30)**
- **Same rules/requirements as all other in district magnet schools. C+ average to get in and maintain enrollment, no major behavior infractions and must maintain good attendance.**
- **Rigorous Curriculum and college credit available.**



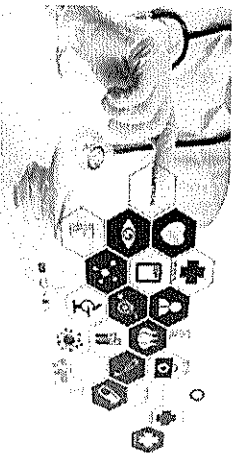


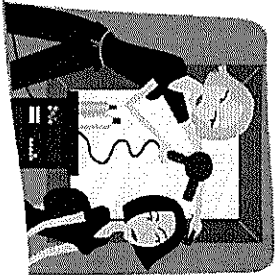
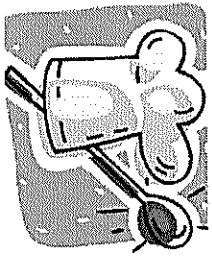

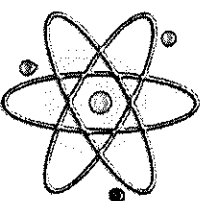
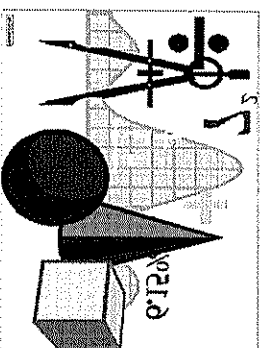
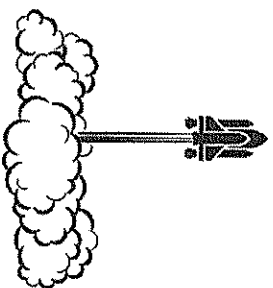


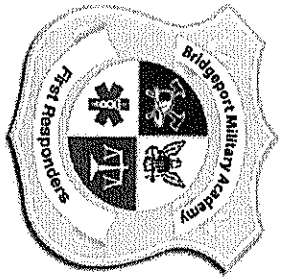
Zoological Science, Research and Biotechnology High School

OPEN CHOICE

At Cooperative Educational Services-State of CT

- The Open Choice program was established by legislation and is intended to reduce racial, ethnic, and economic isolation among students. Through Open Choice, students who are Bridgeport residents have the opportunity to attend school in participating school districts when space is available.

- At Cooperative Educational Services, we serve the Bridgeport region and currently six suburban districts participate with Bridgeport. They are Fairfield, Trumbull, Stratford, Westport, Weston and Easton.

- There are 259 students enrolled in the program for the 2017-18 school year. Once children enter the program they become the responsibility of the receiving district. This means that students will remain in the district until they have completed high school.

- The application will be available January 16 through March 15.

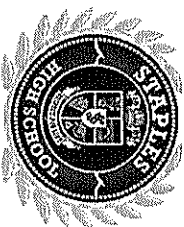
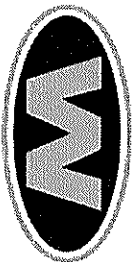
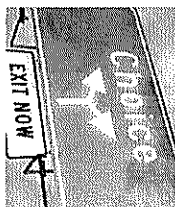
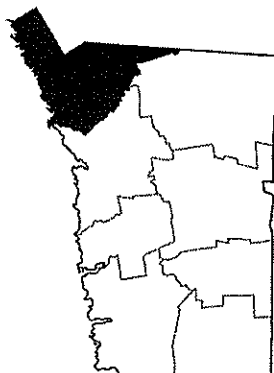
