# MAKE A NAME TENT

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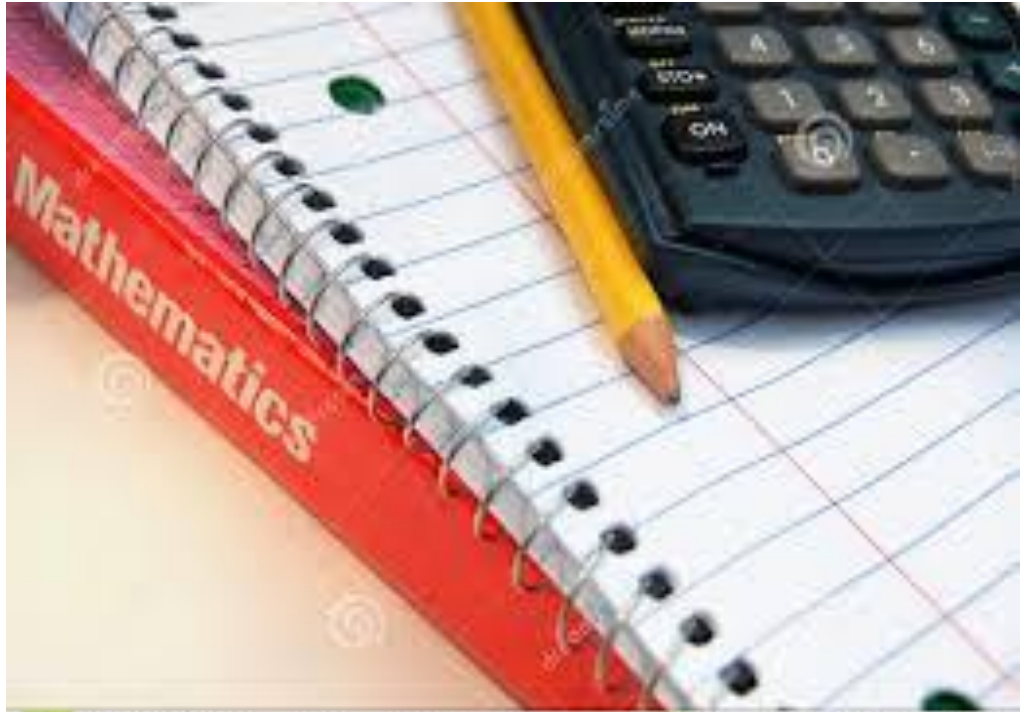
- Your tent will look like an upside-down letter V.

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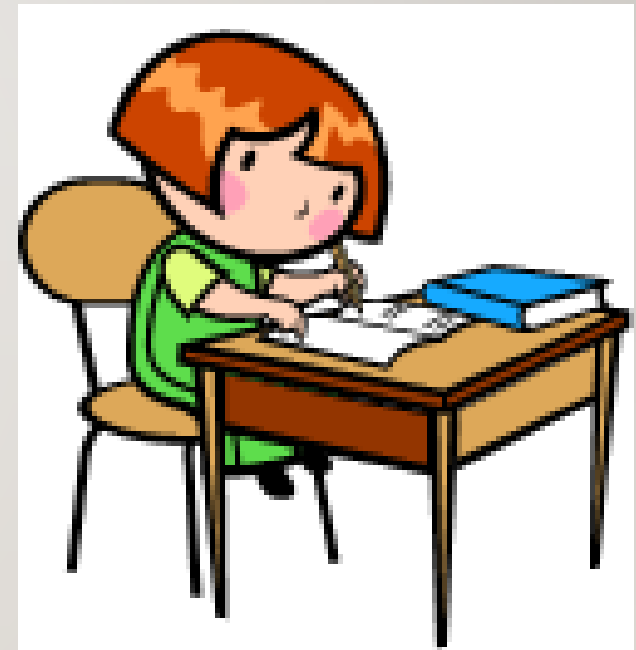

# CLASS RULES

# DURING INSTRUCTION

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# CLASS PROCEDURE

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## 1. Homework is due at 11:59 the same day that is assigned

- All students ( Remote and In person) must submit their homework on TEAMS.
- I DON'T accept late homework, simply because I go over it in class the next day.

## 2. Students are responsible to check TEAMS at least three times daily for any updates or assignments.

- I grade all the assignments on TEAMS and PowerSchool.

## 3. Get missed work from absent bin, check TEAMS, or talk to the teacher

- If you are absent, it is your responsibility to obtain any missed classwork. Follow-up with the teacher if necessary.
- Make arrangements immediately with the teacher, to take missed quizzes and tests. It is your responsibility to make these arrangements. If you do not make-up quizzes in a timely manner, you will earn a “zero” on the homework, classwork, quiz or test.
