

Good Evening Families,

Wednesday October 13th, junior students will be taking the PSAT/NMSQT® and senior students will be taking the SAT here at the Fairchild Wheeler Campus. The PSAT/NMSQT® and the SAT are being offered only at school sites on the Wednesday SAT School Day (October 13th) and specific Saturdays. There is no online version for testing.

Freshmen will take a PSAT 8/9 test and Sophomores will take the PSAT 10. These tests will prepare students for the State administered Spring version of these tests.

Testing will begin at 8:00am so be prompt. There is a very small window where students who arrive after this time will be allowed into the testing rooms.

Test Day Guidelines/Procedures:

1. Children will be provided grab-and-go breakfast upon entering the building. It is a long day, children should bring snacks and water to get them through. They will have lunch and attend their last period class. Dismissal is at 2:10pm as usual.
2. No Cell-Phones
3. Children need to remain in their testing room for the duration of the testing period. They should bring extra reading materials/ school work to work on AFTER they have turned in the test to the proctor.
4. Children should be dressed in "appropriate" school attire i.e.: no pajamas/slippers
5. Children can bring their own scientific calculators into the testing room. Please check the College Board website for the "approved" list of calculators. We will provide one in the event that a junior or senior does not bring one. Freshmen and Sophomore students should bring their own calculator.
6. Masks MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES.
7. Testing rooms have been assigned and will be posted at the school and campus entrances so students know where they need to report. Signage will also be posted within the buildings indicating the child's testing site.
